December 26. 1687 at a meeting of this this towne Lieutenant John Groot for ends best known to him self refusing to serve in y^e place of a solott man the towne voted to chuse a Nothw in his stead. and forth with the towne Chose Sarge James Barnat to serve in his stead for y^e year ensuing.

voted that Loist Barnat and shall bee left to his liberty whether hee will leave a middoll ally in the new meeting house or shull up the soate as they are in Durham meeting house provided allwaies that the soates doe comfortably and roomily hold the house and containe severall men in any one of the soates and seven women in the other end of the soates

voted that the towne Clarke shall record the troopers list both of Country & County that the Constables of this town have brought or shall bring to ye Clarke

voted and agreed that Eliaz Keyes and samuall wright have liberty granted them to take in and carry away all of Land lying and booying between the land of Sarge Edward wright and the land of Jacob Browne and the high way that leads in to the woods space and terme of five years and at the end of five years to surrender and throw up the land to the townes use againe

voted and determined that y^e towne doe sell to Joseph Chamberlin five Acres of Land for fower pound of current money of new england to bee paid unto the townes of Sudbury or their assigns the 25 day of Decembar in the year of our Lord god 1688. and also to make and maintain a good and sufficient way for ever att the said Joseph Chamberlins proper cost and Charge to bee and remain for the townes use and service
