At a Townall towns meeting the thirteenth of February 1687
it was joyntly concluded agreed and voted that the most
wile for seating of persons in the meeting house shall
be by what they pay to the building thereof of Exemption
respect to some particular persons as to age and other
considerable Qualifications
Voted and agreed all the same time that the Town do choose
a Comitty of able persons to remove the new meeting
of Deacon John Flaind when it is finished according unto
Covenant made between him and the town Set town Feb 27
and also to appoint persons how and where to sit in y
meeting house the Comitty chosen was as followeth
