men James Shormans last half year rate beginning first of

July the 17 1689 at a town meeting legally warned  
for the transaction of the following business of the day  
it was to have each mans proportion to the last rate  
for the payment of the new meeting house which being  
road. Deliberately and each man seemed well satisfied  
it was then voted and agreed by the inhabitants of the town  
that the said rate should be delivered to Mr Joseph Noyse  
who then presented him self as agent for Left Daniel  
voted and agreed that there shall be a rate of twenty p<sup>er</sup> cent  
for the repairation of the highway in and about this town  
and that John Allen Joseph Curtis Peter Haines and Benjamin  
more are chosen Surveies to see that this rate be wrought  
out according to each mans proportion

voted that Mr Peter Noyse his 3 youngest daughters shall  
sit in the new pub and that her doo here forward  
relinquish his right in the 2d seat in the side gallery  
also Peter Haines hath another daughter left in the new  
and his seat in the side gallery relinquished also.  
Capt Brown daughter Mary and Capt Crooks daughter Susan  
are also placed in the pub

voted and determined that Capt Grov. Capt Brown John Noyse  
Benjamin parmenter are appointed by the town to view and state  
that bill of land that Jonathan Stanhope Deserveth of y<sup>e</sup> town  
whoever his new barn is erected

August y<sup>e</sup> 20 1689 being a town meeting legally  
warned by our John Goodnow and Lieut Edward Wright  
Chosen by the town to take and Inveitor of the ratable  
estate of all persons in and about this town of Sudbury  
And also Lieut Wright is Chosen Commissioner to Joyn with y<sup>e</sup>  
select men in making of the rentory rate when it  
shall be required according to Law.

1689 September the thirtieth at a town meeting legally warned  
for the hearing of mon<sup>ies</sup> offered in veitor of their estates  
some men refusing to give any in veitor at all the town  
voted and ordered that all persons that did so refuse  
should be by the select men rated will and do as  
excepting John Haines juner who was by the town  
in mitted considering the hand of god that had ben  
upon him
