me James Shermans halfe year rate beginning in march and ending
with August was delivered by order of the Selectmen of this Town
into Shermans owne hands the 6th of novem. Anno Domi. 1690

At a meeting of the Select men novem. the 5th 1690 Elizer whitney covine
had and agreed to sweep the meeting house and brush the
seates carefully and also to shut the windows and Doors for w^{ch} the
Select men in behalf of town have promised Elizer whitney thirty
shillings a year to be paid in shillings.
