Town officers June the first worth and six hundred and ninety
and one for the year ensuing Select men chosen
voted and agreed in the same meeting
to back only one invoice for the hole year
voted and agreed that m^r Peter Noyes
shall have the land that his new borne
stands upon at water town line, even
so much land as will satisfy him for
the money as is wanting to pay for the Town
ne powder. And Ser Jonathan Stanhop
John Allen cor John Parmiter ar chosen a
committie to inspect the S^d Land and bring
an account to the Town what will satisfy
the S^d Noyes. Also voted and agreed
at the same meeting that Joseph Curtis has
liberty to laie down nine ackers of land
Curtiswick was formerly Ser freman^s land by
comon Swamp. And has liberty to back up
nine ackers of land in lew of the S^d land
laied down at the end of his owne land
ixring to Cat. Brownes piece of meadow
and Decon John Haines Joseph Noyes capt.
Brown to mesure out the S^d land and to receive the fore S^d
nine ackers of land to be laied down for the Towns use.
Also voted and agreed at the same meeting that the timber of S^d
land shall be preserved for the Towns use and noe man
to fel on tree uppon S^d land on the penalty of ninten shilling
forfitur to the Towns use without special order from the Town
