authorise by the town to lay it out and make return to the town of same
Capt Jacob moor desired to by half an acre of land of the town joyning to his own
land by thomas Knyp Joseph Curtis and Capt Grount as appointed to view and make

voted and ordered the day above writton that the select men of Sudbury doe
assess the inhabitants of this town in a rate of eight p^{er} cent ^{on their} money to be
improved for the sending and transporting of thomas Blake to old England

the transport of thomas Blake to England and the plimpton as appointed to view a piece of land
that Capt Jacob moor desired to by of the town and make report next meeting

voted that the first munday in february next shall bee a generall town meeting
where in all the inhabitants of the town are to bring in particular lists fairly
written of all their estate roall and paymable rateable and such persons as
shall either neglect or refuse so to do except hindered by sum in
reasonable providence of God shall by the select men bee rated
will and dooms

or if any man keep out to be rated double
