and determined that four votes for the east side of the river for far
as the town bounds do extend norward ad est ward as far as pin
Brook South ward. and for the farm end. so far as our town do extend
Sargent. Elvason Jonathan Rivo are appointed Surveyor
for the west side of the river Thomas plimpton and Nathaniel Rivo
are for the north quarter of the town and Javitt Benjamin moor
and James Smith for the south quarter of the town and all the
said Surveyor have the like power in each others presented if
need shall require
